Admission policy

Our school is open to all children regardless of race and gender. We do, however, give preference to children from Christian homes. [See religious policy]

Children of other faiths are accepted on condition that parents sign a consent form to the effect that their children will be subjected to Christian teachings as applied by the school.

On application, parents will receive an information brochure and an application form.

Any misleading or incorrect information form, or any withheld information, will lead to a failed application.

Normally applicants from pre-school and grade 0 are accepted into the school without an entrance test, provided that space is available and according to the preference of the school

Applicants from grade 1 to grade 10 will be interviewed with their parents to discuss the ethos and spirit of the school. As a rule, applications for grade 11 and 12 are not considered

Parents will be informed verbally and by official letter on the outcome of the interview. A policy brochure will be provided.

On acceptance, parents will have to sign a contractual agreement and pay the required registration fee.

There is a compulsory annual re-registration for all incumbent pupils. Re-registration is not automatic. The principal and his or her management team decide on re-registrations. A prescribed re-registration fee is payable, but this will form part of the school fees for the New Year.
